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
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INTRODUCTION



Summer Intro

- Juniata offers the opportunity to take advantage of the campus and its housing spaces from May 12 through August 3. Students may require summer housing due to a multitude of reasons including summer employment, athletics, research, summer classes, or miscellaneous circumstances.
- Because of the many different activities occurring over the summer, we offer only limited spaces to students for Summer Housing. Not all spaces will have private kitchen access. Spaces are limited and you may not get your first choice of spaces.
- You will receive all summer information and select housing at the summer housing meeting on Reading Day.

The 2024 summer term begins May 12th, 2024 and ends August 3rd, 2024.

SUMMER HOUSING

Breakdown

Summer Application

Application will open **March 20th** and close **May 1st**.

There will be a Summer Housing meeting on Reading Day, **May 2nd**, where students will hear about all summer information and select their summer housing.

- We will use Housing Selection Priority Numbers to determine selection order.
- Students who are not on campus for the entire summer may not be able to select housing at this time.

Summer Room Options

We vary space each summer depending on the Camps and Conferences Office and any work being done in buildings. We will use some of our houses and apartments as well as one tower of East.

****New this year - Field Station housing.** A Select number of students can stay at the Field Station during the summer for the same fee.

Students who have an approved housing accommodation will be provided housing that meets the need.

Important Dates

- First Day of Summer Housing:
 - **May 12th.**
- Last Day of Summer Housing:
 - **August 3rd.**
- Beginning August 4, you will be considered an Early Arrival.
- Need to move out in the middle of the summer?
 - Notify the Campus Life Office prior to departure and turn in your key.
- Fall classes begin on August 22.

Check In/Check Out

- Rooms will be ready a week after commencement. You will return your old room key via Express Checkout form to the drop box outside the Campus Life Office and are responsible for cleaning your room and completing a proper checkout. You will **check-in** with the summer RA and complete an RCR for the summer room.
- When you **check out** for summer, you will turn in your key to either the summer RA or drop it in the drop box outside the Campus Life Office. All belongings must be removed prior to your departure. You are responsible for any damages not listed on your summer RCR.

Moving Logistics/Expectations

Moving Logistics

- Once you receive notification that your summer room is available, you will have 48 hours to move from your spring residence to your summer residence.
- We do not provide moving services for summer housing. Carts are available in the Campus Life Office for use.
- You will move to your Fall 2024 residence around August 4th.

SUMMER BILLING

- Cost for summer housing is \$100/week and billed Sunday-Saturday. Charges for summer housing begin May 12th. You will be billed for any week that you and/or your belongings are on campus.
- Stayovers after August 3rd will be considered an 'early arrival'. The rate will continue to be \$100 per week through August 17th.
- The Bursar's Office can answer specific billing questions.

Expectations

- All campus policies apply during the summer months.
- Guests are not allowed in campus housing during the summer. Large gatherings are also not permitted.
- Watch for emails regarding your summer housing assignment and move in, move out dates.
- Do not leaving belongings unattended. If you have items in the space, you will be billed.

Campus Life

DURING SUMMER

Dining & Meal Plans

- Meal plans are not available, but a kitchen is available for use with limited cooking supplies.

Mail Services

- Please notify the Post Office of your summer stay on campus. Otherwise, they will forward your mail to your home address.
- Post Office is open 10am-3pm weekdays only, during the summer.

Parking / Other Services

- Campus Parking is available. You can use the Parking Pass issued by Public Safety during the semester or you can stop by their office to purchase one.
- Street parking is monitored by the Huntingdon County Borough.
- Kennedy Fitness Center Hours - 9am-4pm
- Statton Learning Common Hours - TBD
- Health Care Services - is closed during the summer.
- Public Safety - open 24/7 7 days a week
 - call 814-641-3636 for emergencies

Lockouts & Work Orders

- Locked out of your room? Call the Office of Campus Life during business hours (8am-4pm). If outside of those hours, please call JCPS at 814-641-3636

FAQS

When will I be notified about my summer housing assignment?

- You will select your summer housing during the Summer Housing Meeting on Reading Day. If you do not receive an assignment at that time, you will be notified prior to your arrival to campus.

Is there moving assistance available into my summer room?

- We do not offer assistance in moving items into your summer room at this time. There are carts available in the Campus Life Office for checkout.

Can I stay on campus for all or part of the summer?

- Both staying on campus for all or just part of summer are possibilities; billing rates are standard throughout the months being \$100 per week Sunday through Saturday.

I need to arrive late/early? What should I do?

- Be sure to note your dates on your housing application. We will use this information for billing.
- Reach out to our Summer Staff or the Campus Life Office to notify of any arrival/departure changes.

What if I need to stay from August 3rd through the start of classes?

- Students who plan to stay after August 3rd will be considered an *Early Arrival*. There will be an Early Arrival application open in July, cost will continue to be \$100 per week.

Will my space be air-conditioned?

- No. College owned houses and apartments do not have AC installed; however, you may bring your own 5000 BTU window unit without a medical accommodation and request to have it installed. The cost is \$100 per the summer period.

Is there anywhere I can store my stuff?

- We do not currently have part time storage units for use on campus but there are several storage facilities near campus.

If I leave campus, can I keep my stuff in my room or will I be charged?

- We do enforce a policy in which leaving one's belongings is considered occupying a summer room which results in charges to your summer rate.

Can graduated students stay on campus for the summer?

- While we do not offer summer housing for students who have graduated, we offer a two week grace period for the transition off campus post graduation.
