

The Wise Endowment for Faculty Strength can support two summer grants of \$2500 each to support the scholarly activity of faculty. All full-time faculty are eligible to apply. Applications are due in the Office of the Provost by Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm. Decisions will be shared with applicants no later than Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>.

Wise Summer Grants support proposals for scholarly projects on which substantial progress can be made during the summer. The project should lead to an identifiable outcome, such as a chapter in a book, an article in an academic publication, poems, a play, a short story, or a conference paper. The project may be part of a larger program of research, but should have a scope and expected result suited to the summer period.

Recipients are required to submit a written report detailing the results of the grant. Half the award will be made on June 30<sup>th</sup>; the balance will be paid when an acceptable report is received but no later than November 1<sup>st</sup>.

Proposals should not exceed 3 single-spaced pages and should describe the scope and nature of the project, the significance of the project, methodology, and likely outcome. It should be accompanied by a current c.v., bibliography pertinent to the project, and list of three references.
