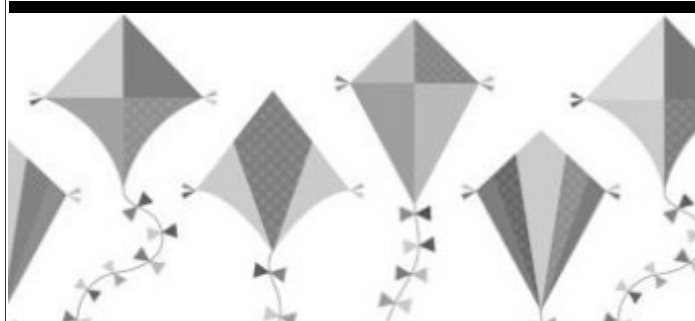

Intern of the Month

Juniata student Rounida Shwaish had a summer internship at the Shuman Juvenile Detention Center in Pittsburgh for the Social Services Department. She got the internship because she was really interested in prison reform. She knew about the facility previously. Her daily responsibilities were to conduct resident orientations and health screenings, maintain communications with probation officers, lawyers, and parents of residents, as well as create and provide recreational activities for residents on a weekly basis. Rounida also got to sit in on court proceedings, hearings, and shadow personnel in the prison. She said, "It really helped me to see what a government job entails and the inner workings of a detention center." She really enjoyed working with her bosses and colleagues in the social services department, and was able to learn a lot from them while maintaining great relationships.

Rounida is graduating this year with a degree in Applied Sociology. The most interesting part of her internship was visiting resident treatment facilities, and being able to see some of the residents that came through facilities and various types of treatments. She feels that, "Many people view juvenile criminals in a negative light, but my internship really helped me put a face to a story and an offense, and sympathize with some of the residents."

Non-Credit Transcript Notation

Did you know that your summer job could also double as an internship? Qualifications for a summer internship: A minimum of 240 hours, consist of pre-professional and academically-valid responsibilities related to your POE, and be performed in accordance with guidelines—The job can be a paid OR volunteer position. If approved, a summer internship will appear on your official transcript (without grade or credit). Having a summer job qualifies as an internship, which requires satisfactory completion of various criteria.
