To apply, please submit: Resume, Transcript, Faculty Recommendation, Job Details/Description, Estimate of Living Expenses, and a 1 Page Essay on "How will this experience advance my future career plans?"

Deadline: Student will submit all required application documents by **March 1, 2014** (Note: this is a rolling date. We will consider additional candidates after this date pending funding availability).
