#### INTERN OF THE MONTH

During the summer of 2022, Joshua Duggan '23, Environmental Science POE, interned with the environmental program at Fort A.P. Hill (FAPH). FAPH is a heavily forested military base located in Caroline County, Virginia. Joshua worked specifically under the Environmental and Natural Resources Division (ENRD) of the Directorate of Public Works (DPW). The ENRD was further split into several subdivisions, including Compliance, Forestry, Wildlife, Threatened and Endangered Species (T&E), and Cultural. While Joshua spent the majority of his time with the Compliance division, he also had the opportunity to complete tasks under other divisions, such as T&E surveys, forest resource inventories, shovel testing for cultural artifacts, many types of inspections, and a low water construction project, which included siphoning a pond over a hill to deposit it in the creek on the other side. As a result of being pushed way beyond his comfort zone, Joshua credits this experience with helping him grow personally and professionally, as well as providing clarity to his plans after graduation. Joshua states, "I learned some technical skills such as animal and plant identification, siphon construction and operation, clock gauge calibration, spill response, wetland delineation, and more. Learning all these skills built my confidence, and my passion for the outdoors only grew as a result. It taught me who I was, who I wanted to become, and how to get there.
