**The Health Center** is open from Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 3:30 p.m. and Monday evenings from 6:00 to 8:00. In addition to the treatment of minor injuries and illnesses, we offer the following services:

### Physical Exams

Available free of charge for driver's licenses, jobs, student teaching and other needs. Physicals are only performed during the physician's hours on Wednesdays and Fridays.

### Gynecological Exams

Students must make appointments with the Health and Wellness Center. The exam is free. Bills for any lab work sent to J.C. Blair Hospital will be submitted to student's insurance company.

### Allergy Shots

Students may receive maintenance allergy injections during Physician's hours Monday 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. and Wednesday from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 to 3:30 p.m.



*Allergy injections are available during physician's hours.*

### Flu Shots

Available at the Health and Wellness Center beginning in October. There is a charge for flu shots—usually \$15.00.

### PPD/TB Testing

Any student who needs a TB test for any reason can get one free of charge at the Health Center.

### Osteopathic Manipulation

Sessions are available by appointment the first and third Friday mornings of the month. There is no charge to students.

### Lab Work

Some lab work may be performed at the Health Center free of charge, while some will need to be sent to J.C. Blair Memorial Hospital. Bills for lab work performed at J.C. Blair Hospital will be sent to students' insurance company. The Health Center will perform lab work Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 2:00 p.m.

### Absence due to illness

The Health Center does not provide notes or excuses for minor illnesses or injuries that result in missed classes. In such instances, the student should correspond directly with the professor.
